TRANSITIONAL HOUSING

The Village Transitional Housing Program provides a low cost housing option for youth aging out of the foster care system. The goal of the Village is to provide a safe living environment and support services for young men and women living in Central Florida, ages 18 to 23, that will increase the probability of success as they transition into adulthood. Services include educational support and employment readiness training, charactering building through volunteering, community development and supportive services.

INDEPENDENT LIVING SERVICES

This program helps prepare teenagers in the foster care system and support them after they turn 18. While in care, staff develop essential life skills in order to live independently and become self-sufficient adults. The goal of this program is to provide an added support system to ensure that foster youth are afforded every opportunity to complete their education, develop self-sufficiency skills, and become productive members of society. Services include case management, mentoring, life skills assessment and training, life skills training plans, life skills training opportunities, transitional living and support services.

ADOPTION SERVICES

This program recruits and trains parents interested in adopting children who have been abused and neglected. Parents receive continuous guidance and support throughout the adoption process by finding the right match between the child and parent, and assistance in the management of the legal process.

FOSTER CARE SERVICES

Foster Care Services are designed to provide a positive and nurturing home for children removed from their home due to abuse and neglect. The goal is to unite these children with committed families that can provide an open heart and safe, stable home. The program licensed through the Department of Children and Families for children and adolescents.

Through the team approach, treatment focuses on the growth and developmental needs of each child and support for the foster parent. Within a home environment, we work together to reduce problem behaviors and address therapeutic issues of both the children and their parents in order to return children to a permanent home.

EDUCATION LIAISON PROGRAM

This program is designed for all school-aged children in Orange County placed in licensed out-of-home care. The focus is on the educational needs of foster youth to ensure educational goals are met and the youth graduate with a regular diploma. A primary responsibility of the Educational Liaisons is to provide advocacy for foster youth who are facing challenges to being successful in school. The program also provides support, collaboration, and sharing of information among independent living coordinators, family case managers, caregivers, students and school personnel to ensure continuity of educational needs and resources in support of the youth.

JUVENILE JUSTICE SERVICES

Mental Health and Substance Abuse assessment and intervention to youth in Juvenile Detention Centers.

OUTPATIENT SERVICES

Outpatient Services provides treatment to children, adolescents and their families who are experiencing mental health, substance abuse or behavioral problems. Services are provided in a community settings such as a child's home or school. We specialize in treating problem behaviors and offer skill training in areas such as social skills.

Services include:

Behavior Analysis: Includes behavioral assessment, development of behavior management programs, and parent and teacher training in behavioral interventions. Services are provided by Certified Behavior Analysts, Certified associate Behavior Analysts or clinicians eligible for certification under the supervision of a Certified Behavior Analyst.

Counseling: Includes individual, group, and family counseling provided by Master's level clinicians under the supervision of a licensed clinician.

Clinics: This program offers psychiatric evaluation and medication management provided by board-certified Psychiatrist and Advanced Registered Nurse Practitioners.

EDUCATION AND TRAINING

Intervention Services is an approved continuing education (CEU) provider for Florida licensed Psychologists (#PCE-51); LCSW, LMHC, LMFT (#BAP-266), and Board Certified Behavior Analysts (#OP-01-0010). Workshops are offered to staff and community professionals several times each year at a reasonable fee. Internships are available for those seeking supervised experience toward certification or licensure.
